PROJECTS THIS ACADEMINC YEAR!

FOREST SCHOOL- WORKING WITH TWO PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN A LONG TERM PROGRAMME WITH 60 CHILDREN. FOREST SCHOOL PRE-SCHOOL/FAMILY GROUP AND HOME EDUCATION FOREST SCHOOL. SUMMER HOLIDAY SESSION WITH AIMING HIGH FOR DISABLED CHILDREN. FOREST SCHOOL TRANSITION PROJECT- WORKING WITH 13 CHILDREN FROM 5 PRIMARY SCHOOLS CREATING A WILD SPACE ON THE GROUNDS OF THEIR NEW HIGH SCHOOL.
